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### POLICY STATEMENT:

Buffalo Trail Public Schools believes that every student has the right to access the knowledge, skills, and attitudes they need to be self-reliant, responsible, caring, and positive contributing members of society. Acquiring knowledge, skills and attitudes is a shared responsibility between the students, the parents/guardians, the school and the community.

### GUIDING PRINCIPLES:

1. Student admission will be subject to the provisions of the *Education Act*. (201.1AP Entrance Age) Children who fall outside the provisions of the *Education Act* may be permitted to enrol in school where funding and appropriate programming can be provided. (201.1AP Entrance Age)
2. The Board supports participation in reciprocal exchange programs or the acceptance of foreign students where space and appropriate programming is available. (201.2AP Admission of Exchange Students Admin Procedures, 201.3AP Admission of Foreign Students Admin

Procedures)

3. The Board recognizes the rights of a student determined to be independent according to the *Education Act*. (201.4AP Independent Student Admin Procedures)
4. While the Board understands that the current funding structure requires the levying of supplemental fees, they recognize that these fees may have significant impact and all steps should be taken to minimize the additional cost to parents/guardians. (201.5AP Student Fees)
