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The Board of Trustees believes that all students should have the right to a safe and caring learning environment. Therefore, the Board forbids the practice known as “hazing”, that is, the subjection of students to various forms of punishments or indignities.

### **GENERAL PROCEDURES:**

1. The subjection of students to hazing is forbidden, whether:
  - 1.1 On the school premises,
  - 1.2 In connection with school activities on or off the school premises,
  - 1.3 To and from school.
2. For introducing new students to a school, “welcome activities” rather than “frosh” activities are encouraged.
3. In determining what constitutes hazing and welcome activities, the decision of the school administration shall be final.
4. Any student participating in hazing will be disciplined according to school and division policy.
