November was a busy month for the Board of Trustees at BTPS. They approved the Annual Audited Financial Statement and the Annual Education Results Report (AERR). These are found on our website under Reports.

The Buffalo Trail Public Schools Four Year Education Plan for 2019-2023 Year Three Report and the Annual Education Results Report for 2021-2022 is created to reflect the division's mission, vision, and values. Our results indicate that BTPS is characterized by high levels of high school completion, with 86% of students graduating within three years of entering grade 10, and 92% within five years. 84% of teachers, parents and students agree that students are satisfied with the overall education in BTPS, and 92% of parents share that their child is safe at school. We are proud of the work that our staff do in our schools so we are able to achieve these results.

November 21-25 is Education Worker Recognition Week and BTPS has amazing staff who ensure we maintain our safe and caring environment. Please see our recognition and thank you to our staff on our website. We are proud of our staffs' contributions to all students' success.
